There is a precision and sharpness to the 2015 Cavaliere that I don't think we've seen from this estate in the past. It's light garnet in color, with notes of violets and red berry fruit, some minerality in there, and then dusty tannins on the close. There is some real sharpness to this monovarietal Sangiovese from the Tuscan Coast.

Michele Satta has created a new wine called Marianova. A 50-50 blend of Sangiovese and Syrah, the wine represents a blend of grapes that is unique for the appellation and underlines the fierce spirit of independence that is encapsulated in all of Satta's wines. Marianova debuted with the 2015 vintage, and only 3,000 bottles were made. This estate farms 24 hectares
